Headlines

Church meeting headlines - Sunday 26th November, 3rd & 31st December 2023 Church members should have received a copy of the minutes from the last church meetings. If you haven't, please speak to Faith (printed copies will be given out on Sunday).

Below is a summary of the key headlines from the meetings: Any other items in the meeting are covered elsewhere in the newsflash.

- Thanks were given to Trevor Tilley and Jasper Harding for the work they did in organising the roof repair
- Adrian and Jill Lovett were brought into membership. We now have 75 members
- The homecall of Maureen Peskett was minuted
- We are over budget for 2023 due to the roof repairs coming in this year and increased mortgage rates, but some cost savings in utilities
- Budget for 2024 was approved
- A legacy gift of just over £100,000 has been given to the church, most of which will go towards the church mortgage
- Due to our decrease in giving we have had to reduce our budgeted mission giving for 2024
- Janet will be retiring as our housekeeper at the end of the year
- We will be having a permanent prayer room set up in meeting room 2 (blue room) upstairs. This will be trialled from January to Easter
- We are looking at restarting our toddler group and are currently looking at plans of how this might happen
- Messy Church has now stopped but will be looking to evolve it in some way, with a suggestion of running something on a Friday afternoon
- At the meeting on 3rd December Clive Phillips and Jasper Harding were relected to the leadership team. Kay Chesters was elected to the leadership team

• At the meeting on 31st December Emily Moores became a church member

The next meeting will be on Sunday 21st January at 1:30pm, following the service and lunch.
