**TryPraying** 

Last Sunday, we launched our new 'TryPraying' outreach initiative, helping ordinary people learn how to pray and discover God's kindness for themselves in just 7 days. You can collect a book, including ones for children, any time in October from the church building and at our services. There is also an electronic version and, for iPhone users, you can download the app.

Here is one way the initiative can work over the next few months:

October: Pray - Use the book yourself and pray for the person you're going to give it to.

**November**: Give - Find a time to give it away.

**December**: Invite – Invite the person to our Christmas events and or Alpha in January

The Vision: What if everyone in the church gave a booklet away, and everyone who received one encountered Jesus in some way? What if we had 100 guests at Alpha? What if we had 100 baptisms at Easter?

Please pray into this initiative as we reach out together.

And as we do, let's remember that there is 'rejoicing in Heaven over one sinner who repents' (Luke 15:7)

We are also looking for people to help pack the boxes on **Tuesday 22nd October**, 10am until 12pm. If you can help on this date, please let Kay Chesters know.



- Buddy bench This is now at Trafalgar school and will be having a plaque put on it
