'TryPraying' is an outreach initiative, helping ordinary people learn how to pray and discover God's kindness for themselves in just 7 days. You can collect a book, including ones for children, any time in October from the church building and at our services. There is also an <u>electronic version</u> and, for iPhone users, you can <u>download the app</u>.

Here is one way the initiative can work over the next few months:

October: Pray - Use the book yourself and pray for the person you're going to give it to.

November: Give - Find a time to give it away.

December: Invite – Invite the person to our Christmas events and or Alpha in January

The Vision: What if everyone in the church gave a booklet away, and everyone who received one encountered Jesus in some way? What if we had 100 guests at Alpha? What if we had 100 baptisms at Easter?
