

Church meeting headlines - Sunday 6th April 2025

Church members should have received a copy of the minutes from the last church meeting. If you haven't, please speak to Faith (printed copies will be given out on Sunday).

Below is a summary of the key headlines from the meeting:

Any other items in the meeting have been previously mentioned or are covered elsewhere in the newsflash.

- The AGM, held at the beginning of the meeting, included reports on Safeguarding and Health & Safety, the Annual & Financial Reports for 2024, the appointment of our auditors and the affirming of all church policies, which can be viewed on our website.
- Alpha concluded last week. We had 13 guests, most of whom attended every week
 and, in a small way, want to continue their journey in faith. 6 of the adults will be
 doing a course called 'First Steps' for 8-weeks with Aaron and Becca Yonkoski. We
 will be starting a youth group on Friday nights from 25th April. We have 3 people on
 the team so far. If you'd like to help, please speak to Faith or Jon.
- Feedback from the Horsham Baptists Together service was positive from all 3

- churches, with suggestions of a few tweaks. Over 180 people attended. Another service will be held on Sunday 1st March 2026, which TRBC will host.
- Samson Wong came into membership. We received resignations from Adrian & Jill Lovett, Matt & Claire Norgate, and Peter & Lisa Rainier. We now have 70 members.
- Our Gift Day will be on Sunday 8th June. £12,500 target. The money raised will
 partially go towards the new boiler and various projects around the building.
- The members voted on and, by a majority, agreed to adopt a statement on samesex marriage. This is available on request.
- The members continued their discussions on the values of TRBC. If you have any thoughts on this, please speak to Jon.
