Praying for Friday Youth

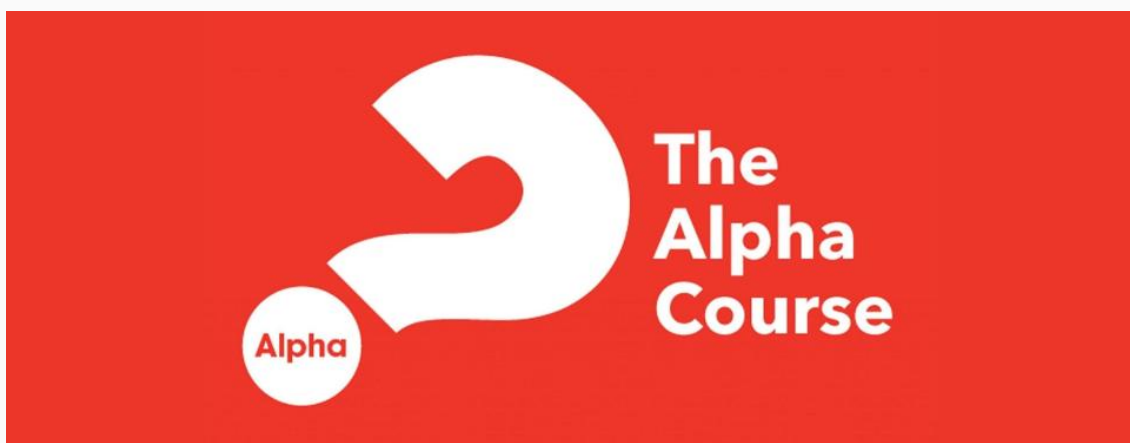
As mentioned at the church members' meeting, Friday Youth will take a break starting from March, with a relaunch planned for September.
